

Afghanistan National Rules Supplement 2010 Philip C. Jessup International Law Moot Court Competition

In accordance with Official Rule 1.5 and in the interest of promoting efficiency in the application of the 2010 Jessup Official Rules in challenging environments, the Afghanistan National Administrator has adopted the following National Rules:

I. Submission of Memorials supplement to Official Rule 6.1:

- Article 1: All teams are required to submit their memorials no later than 12:00 pm (noon) local time on 12 January 2010 to the Afghanistan National Administrator by email at ghrezamohammady@gmail.com; or in the alternative, by delivering the memorials in electronic format (e.g., on a flash drive) to the National Administrator so that it arrives by 12:00pm (noon) local time on 12 January 2010.
- Article 2: It is recommended that both Applicant and Respondent Memorials be attached and sent in one email.
- Article 3: If a team is not able to submit both memorials in one email before the National or International Deadline, it is possible to submit the memorials in separate emails. National penalties will only be imposed on the memorial submitted after the deadline.
- Article 4: The National Administrator shall submit all memorials received prior to the international deadline to the ILSA Executive Office at Jessup@ilsa.org no later than 11:59 pm local time on 12 January 2010.
- Article 5: The National Administrator shall submit each team's memorials to the ILSA Executive Office in separate emails.
- Article 6: The National Administrator is not responsible for submitting any memorials received later than 11:55 pm local time on 12 January to the ILSA Executive Office. After this time, teams are responsible for submitting their own memorials directly to the ILSA Executive Office at jessup@ilsa.org.

II. Memorial Penalties supplement to Official Rule 11.1:

- Article 1: Memorials submitted after the national deadline may incur up to 4 penalty points.
- Article 2: The National Administrator has the discretion to waive any penalty points mentioned in the present supplemental rules and provides the authoritative interpretation.
