

# **THE 2010 KAZAKH NATIONAL TOURNAMENT**

## **The Kazakh National Supplement**

to the 2010 Official Rules of the Philip C. Jessup International Law  
Moot Court Competition.

The Kazakh National Supplement to the 2010 Official Rules of the Philip C. Jessup International Law Moot Court Competition has been promulgated by Kazakh National Administration with approval of the Executive Director of the International Law Students Association.

### **Supplement to Official Rule 1.0 Organization of the Competition**

#### 1.1 Administration

The Kazakh National Tournament is organized annually by the Kazakh Humanities and Law University and administrated by the Director of the Centre for International Relations and European Law. The Centre for International Relations and European Law is located at:

The Kazakh National Tournament Administrator is Kalisheva Zhannetta and the Coordinator is Akylov Daulet.

#### 1.2 Structure of the Tournament consists of the two levels: (1) Writing Level, and (2) Oral Level.

According to the Kazakh National Schedule the Writing Level is held from 22 December 2009 until 7 January 2010, all Memorials are emailed to Writing Level Judges and graded accordingly. The Oral Level of the Tournament includes Preliminary Rounds, Advanced Rounds and the Kazakh National Championship. The Kazakh National Championship is held on 16-17 January, 2010.

### **Supplement to Official Rule 2.0 Participation and Eligibility**

#### 2.1 Minimum requirements for Team Member eligibility

A person may be a Team Member if he or she:

(a) is pursuing a law bachelor and master degree or an international law-related degree;

(b) is enrolled at an eligible institution as a full-time or part-time student during the relevant academic year and plans to participate in the Competition on behalf of that institution;

(c) has not engaged in the practice of law in any jurisdiction after graduating from any type of law degree program.

## 2.2 ILSA Executive Office's written permission required in certain cases

In addition to satisfying National Supplement to Official Rule 2.1, a person must additionally obtain the written permission of the ILSA Executive Office to be a Team Member if the person:

(a) is enrolled as a visiting or exchange student rather than as a degree candidate, or is otherwise enrolled at more than one institution; or

(b) is serving as an extern or apprentice; or

(c) has already received a graduate or post-graduate degree in a legal field in Kazakhstan (e.g., Master of Law or an international law-related degree) or equivalent

(d) is enrolled in post-graduate studies at universities in the Republic of Kazakhstan, such as “Aspiranture” or “Competitor for Law” or equivalent program in any other country.

## **Supplement to Official Rule 3.0 Team Registration**

### 3.1 Team Registration

In addition to registering with ILSA, each Kazakh Team must register with the Kazakh National Administration by completing a registration form and paying the appropriate registration fee (\$170). Then all Teams must scan a copy of the paying document and send it at [Kz\\_Jesup@mail.ru](mailto:Kz_Jesup@mail.ru) by the registration deadline in the Kazakh National Schedule (**25 November 2009**). Kazakh Teams must also register with the ILSA Executive Office by completing the on-line registration form by the registration deadline in the ILSA Official Schedule (**4 December 2009**).

Each Team must designate an Official Team Contact. Notice to the Team contact constitutes notice to all Team Members.

NOTE: The Registration Deadline by Kazakh National Schedule is earlier than the ILSA Official Schedule. The Kazakh National Administration prepares necessary information about Kazakh Teams and emails it to the ILSA Executive Office by the registration deadline in the ILSA Official Schedule.

## **Supplement to Official Rule 5.0 Judges**

### 5.1 Judge groups

Kazakh Teams' Memorials are given to two groups of Judges.

(1) Writing Level Judges of the National Tournament. According to Kazakh National Supplement 1.2 and the Kazakh National Schedule, Memorials are emailed to Writing Level Judges until 22 December 2009. All content of Memorials remains strictly confidential. Writing Level Judges check the received Memorials from 22 December 2009 to 7 January 2010 and then email the Kazakh National Administration with filled control forms.

(2) Oral Level Judges may serve as judges in any Oral Rounds of the Kazakh National Tournament during 16-17 January 2010 according to Kazakh National Schedule.

NOTE: Kazakh National Administrator chooses persons as Judges conforming to the Official Rules 5.0 of the Philip C. Jessup International Law Moot Court Competition.

## **Supplement to Official Rule 6.0 Memorials**

### 6.1 Submission of Memorials

Each Team participating in the Kazakh National Tournament must send its Applicant and Respondent Memorials via e-mail to the Kazakh National Administration at Kz\_Jessup@mail.ru no later than 23:59 on the date specified in the National Schedule (**20 December 2009**).

NOTE: National Administration prepares the received memorials for sending in the original language via e-mail to the ILSA Executive Office at [jessup@ilsa.org](mailto:jessup@ilsa.org).

### 6.2 Memorial language

The official language of the Kazakh National Tournament is Russian. Kazakh Teams may not submit memorials in any language other than Russian.

NOTE: The Winning Team's Memorial is translated into English by the Kazakh National Administration after the Kazakh National Championship. The Kazakh Winner Team must plead in English during any International Rounds of the 2010 Philip C. Jessup International Law Moot Court Competition.

## **Supplement to Official Rule 12.0 Awards**

### 12.1 Team Awards:

- Kazakh National Champion;
- Second Place Team;
- Third Place Team.

### 12.2 Memorial Awards:

- First Place Memorial

### 12.3 Member Awards:

12.3.1 Award for Participation. The award is presented to every member of Kazakh National Tournament Teams.

### 12.3.2 Oralists Awards:

- First Place Oralist;
- Second Place Oralist;
- Third Place Oralist;
- Fourth Place Oralist.

12.4 Judge Award is presented to all Judges who serve as judges during Writing Level and Oral Level of the Kazakh National Tournament.
