INSTRUCTIONS: For the Advanced Rounds, the decision is based on a majority vote of the bench. Each judge should make an independent review of the teams' memorials and oral arguments. Unless otherwise instructed by the Competition Administrator, judges may employ a point scoring system of their individual choice (including the scoring system from the Preliminary Rounds), and are not required to give any particular fixed weight to either memorials or oral arguments, although both should be considered as part of each team's performance. After the round is over, the bailiff will ask the oralists and audience to leave the room while the bench deliberates. Each judge must select which team he or she believes won the match and should advance in the competition. Judges must mark their decisions on their scoresheets by the end of the deliberation period. Once the winner has been determined based on majority vote of the bench, the presiding judge should instruct the bailiff to invite the teams and audience back into the courtroom. The judges may then introduce themselves and give feedback to the oralists on their performance. After this, unless otherwise instructed by the Competition Administrator, the presiding judge should announce the winner of the round.
