

AZERBAIJANI NATIONAL RULES SUPPLEMENT

This Rules Supplement has been prepared by the Azerbaijani National Administrator of the 2025 Philip C. Jessup International Law Moot Court Competition to supplement and/or modify the Official Rules of the Competition and has been approved by the Executive Director of the International Law Students Association. The purpose of this Supplement is to facilitate organization of Azerbaijani National Rounds of the Competition.

1. Administration of the Azerbaijani National Rounds

- 1.1. Azerbaijani National Rounds are administered by:

2. This Supplement and the Official Rules

- 2.1. This Supplement regulates and applies to the organization of the Azerbaijani National Rounds. Unless otherwise set out or determined in this Supplement, the Official Rules regulate and apply to the organization of the National Rounds as well. The scope of application covers all aspects of the National Rounds.
- 2.2. This Supplement may supplement or replace, where indicated respectively throughout this Supplement, provisions of the Official Rules.
- 2.3. Any questions or issues concerning the application and interpretation of this Supplement shall be addressed to the National Administrator. The Executive Director shall serve as final arbiter in application and interpretation of this Supplement.

3. National Rounds Procedure

3.1. Supplement to the Official Rule 8.

- The National Rounds shall consist of six matches in a Round Robin amongst all three competitors. Each Team shall plead four times, twice as Applicant and twice as Respondent.
- The National Administrator shall determine the pairings and order of those rounds, and shall announce the schedule to all Teams no later than three days before the beginning of the National Rounds.
- Each Team shall receive the Memorials of the other participating Teams via its Team Portal on ILSA.ORG no earlier than seven days prior to the beginning of the National Rounds, but no later than five days prior to the beginning of the National Rounds.
- The Champion and First Runner-up of the Azerbaijani National Rounds will be determined based upon performance in the National Rounds, according to Official Rule 10.9.
